Submission Guidelines

To keep our digital display concise, cohesive and vibrant, please follow these specifications:

- **Format:** Create your pages using **PowerPoint, Google Slides** or **Canva**.
- **Limit:** A maximum of **2 slides** per ensemble. Each slide may include as many photos, articles, and captions as you like. However, remember that too much on one slide can look cluttered and confusing!
- **Content:** We encourage a mix of:
 - Black and white and/or color photos.
 - Scanned newspaper articles.
 - Short, engaging captions recapping your year's highlights.
- **Submission:** This year is **100% online**. Please export your slides as **.pptx** and email to marketing@region10sai.org.

Important Deadline

All submissions must be received by **March 26, 2026**.

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Scrapbook Template & Design Guide

To ensure your memories look their best when projected or viewed digitally, please keep these design tips in mind:

1. Getting Started (Dimensions)

- **Canva:** Use the "Presentation (16:9)" layout.
 - **PowerPoint** and **Google Slides:** Use the default "**Widescreen**" slide size.
- Pro Tip:* This ensures your pages fill the entire screen without black bars on the sides!

2. Layout Inspiration

Since you have a 2-slide maximum, we recommend this split:

- Slide 1: The Big Picture. A large group photo of your chorus or quartet, your name/logo, and a brief "Year in Review" summary (e.g., "A year of growth and harmony!").
- Slide 2: The Highlights. A collage of candid shots, performance clippings, and newspaper articles with short, fun captions.

3. Design Do's and Don'ts

Do	Don't
Use high-resolution photos (avoid blurry screenshots).	Don't put text too close to the very edge of the slide.
Use bold, legible fonts for captions.	Don't use more than 3 different fonts (it gets messy!).
Keep background colors simple so photos pop.	Don't over-clutter; "white space" is your friend.

4. How to Save & Send

Once your masterpiece is finished, please save it using the following naming convention:

EnsembleName_R10_Scrapbook.

- **From Canva:** Click **Share** -> **Download** -> Select **PPTX**
- **From PowerPoint:** Click **File** -> **Export** -> Select **Microsoft PPTX**
- **From Google Slides:** Click **File** -> **Download** -> Select **Microsoft PPTX**
