- Try to avoid too many physically large items – they are often difficult to transport.
- Smaller cost items are welcome as well.
- Baskets should be wrapped to secure items inside.
- Clear wrap is preferable to colored wrap, which is sometimes difficult to see through.
- If your item includes gift cards: Please make a copy of the gift card for item display and place the actual gift card in a separate envelope to give to Megan Rose or Janet Moe.
- Plan for an early arriving chorus/quartet member to bring the item(s) to the Delta room so the auction can be set up ASAP for viewing.
- Remind chorus/quartet members to shop the silent auction!
- While not required, **all choruses and quartets are highly encouraged to contribute**. It's a fantastic way to represent your spirit and support our shared community. Individuals and non-Region 10 members are invited to submit donations as well!
